The FBMF Behaviour Policy derives from the ethos of respect that has been built so far at FBMF, along the lines of the Rules for Pupils, which every individual pupil must adhere to.

Members of the school, both staff and students, must show respect for each other and towards members of the community, not just during the school day but in their lifestyle in any environment. There are forms of behaviour that are totally unacceptable, including bullying, discrimination, verbal and physical abuse and behaving in a way that threatens the safety of any other person.

This policy conforms to these criteria:

- It promotes good behaviour, creating a positive, pleasant and orderly environment for teaching and learning and for developing responsible young people with a strong moral code for adult life.
- It enables all children to fulfil their potential.
- Pupils whose behaviour does not fit the School Behaviour Policy will be punished appropriately in line with procedure. Those pupils demonstrating that their behaviour reflects the policy to a strong degree are recognised and praised.
- Recognition and rewarding of good behaviour and the application of sanctions are monitored to ensure that these procedures are being fairly and consistently applied.
- The FBMF behaviour policy will be reviewed and developed in accordance with best practise in consultation with the appropriate bodies of FBMF staff, directors, parents/carers, pupils and governors.

Every member of the school, staff and students must:

- Feel safe, secure and valued.
- Treat others with respect.
- Be courteous towards others.
- Maintain orderly conduct.
- Promote a good environment for learning.
